Hygiene/Cleaning Measures				
a. Work surfaces are disinfected at appropriate intervals				
b. High use equipment is decontaminated before and after use				
c. Handwashing is encouraged; soap and hand sanitizer is readily available				
d. Hand sanitizer is available at entry and in high traffic locations				
e. Eliminate frequent contact of surfaces (e.g. leave door(s) open where possible)				
Remove appliances, dishes, cutlery, glassware and other commonly used items; staff bring their own				
g. Hygiene / cleaning measures				
Physical Distancing				
a. Identify and post occupancy limits				
b. Stagger lunch/breaks				
c. Stagger hours of work				
d. Establish work from home arrangements				
e. Discourage physical contact of employees
